ABOUT THE BOOK

Eva is at the supermarket. She has a list of things to buy. She takes a grocery cart. She puts all the things in the cart. In the supermarket she meets people she knows.

Answer the questions

In the book, there are questions to the reader. Here are the questions. Answer them together in class.

What do you usually buy at the supermarket?

What flowers do you like?

How often do you buy fruit?

What vegetables do you usually buy?

Do you drink both coffee and tea?

What do you usually eat for lunch?

How often do you eat candy?

How much do you usually spend when you buy groceries?

How do you greet your neighbours?

Missing words

Ask the students to sit in pairs. They will take turns at reading to each other. In every sentence they will make a pause and leave out a word. The other student says the word.

Example:

Eva is at the ... (supermarket)

She has a ... of what to buy. (list)



Dictation

Dictation is a good exercise for reading, pronunciation and listening comprehension. Ask the students to work in pairs. Choose a few sentences from the book. One of the students reads a sentence to the other who writes it down. It is important that the person who reads, divides the sentences into parts and that he/she reads slowly. Write on the board:

. = full stop

The students have the pictures from the book. They write the words under the pictures without looking in the book.
